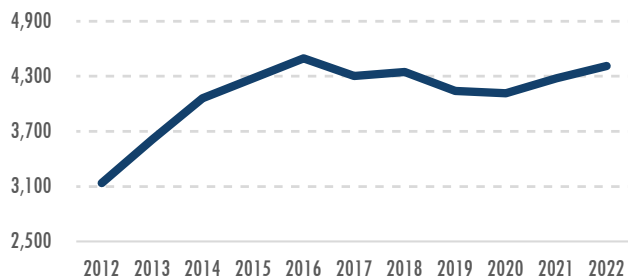


### Speech-Language Pathology Assistants Growth Trends

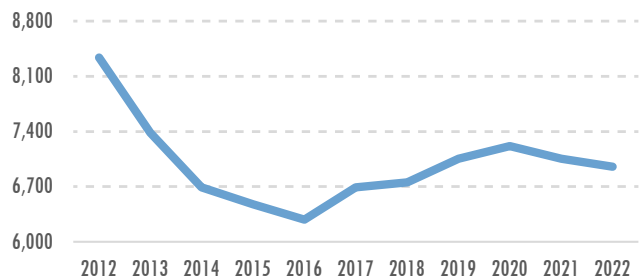
This fact sheet is an overview of the trends, distribution, and demographics of speech-language pathology assistants (SLPAs) in Texas. In 2022, there were 4,411 actively licensed SLPAs in Texas.

- This number represented a 2.5% increase since 2017 and a 40.7% increase since 2012 (Figure 1).

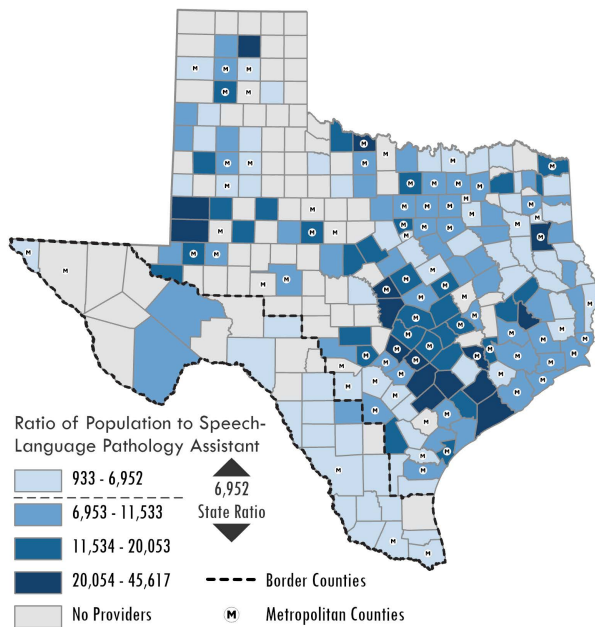


**Figure 2. Ratio of Texas Population to SLPA<sup>1</sup>**

- The ratio of the Texas population per one SLPA in 2012 was 8,338:1 and in 2022 it was 6,952:1. The ratio has decreased by 16.6% over the past 10 years (Figure 2).<sup>1</sup>

**Figure 1. Total SLPAs in Texas**

SLPAs were not evenly distributed throughout the state.

- The ratio of the population to SLPA was higher in metropolitan counties than non-metropolitan counties.
- The ratio of the population to SLPA was higher in non-border counties than border counties.
- 80 counties had no SLPAs (Figure 3).

<sup>1</sup>Population numbers are sourced from the Texas Demographic Center (previously the Texas State Data Center). The center regularly updates the demographic projections. Therefore, population numbers for a particular year may differ depending on the date the data was retrieved.



# Demographics of Speech-Language Pathology Assistants

## Age

Within 10 years, 5.3% of the current Texas SLPA workforce will be over 65 years of age.

- Age data were available for 100% of licensed SLPAs in 2022.
- 0.6% of active SLPAs in Texas were over 65 years of age in 2022.

## Gender

- In 2022, gender data was available for 25.1% of licensed SLPAs. 95.5% of SLPAs were female and 4.5% were male.
- In 2012, 71.1% of licensed SLPAs provided their gender. 95.0% were female and 5.0% were male.

## Age Distribution by Gender

- Among SLPAs over 55 years of age, males comprised 2.8% of the workforce.
- Among SLPAs aged 40 years or under in 2022, 94.2% were female and 5.8% were male.
