

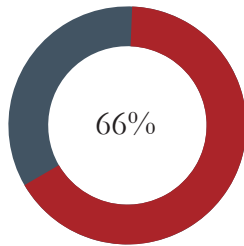

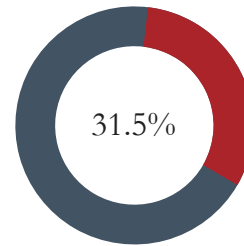
Teen Dating Violence

Texas Youth Risk Behavior Survey 2019

More than half of those who had experienced physical or sexual dating violence had felt sad or hopeless for two weeks or more.



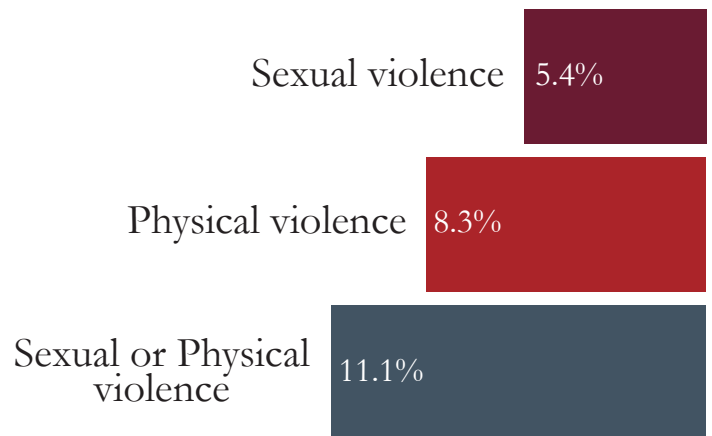
Nearly one-third of those who had experienced sexual or physical dating violence had attempted suicide.



More than double the amount of female students had experienced sexual or physical dating violence than male students.



11.1% of Texas students had experienced sexual, physical, or both types of violence.
