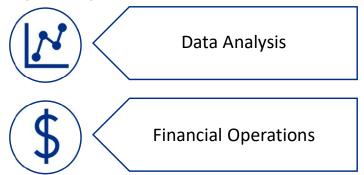


Skills and experiences you may have developed through your degree include:

Examples of Entry-Level Job Postings (with Texas DSHS)

- Data Analyst I
 - Analyze data and report findings for Vital Statistics
- Health Informatics Specialist I
 - Collect and analyze data collected from health information systems (HIS)
- Financial Analyst I
 - Prepare reports on findings and recommendations related to fiscal monitoring
 - Review financial records to ensure compliance with state/federal laws
- Data Entry Operator
 - Enter complex data for various programs, and make corrections as needed
