- **Data Analyst I**
 - Analyze data and report findings for Vital Statistics
- **Health Informatics Specialist I**
 - Collect and analyze data collected from health information systems (HIS)
- **Financial Analyst I**
 - Prepare reports on findings and recommendations related to fiscal monitoring
 - Review financial records to ensure compliance with state/federal laws
- **Data Entry Operator**
 - Enter complex data for various programs, and make corrections as needed
