- Texas Health Steps Program Specialist II
  - Recruit and retain medical/dental providers by providing technical assistance
  - Develop and conduct training programs on policies and procedures as requested by providers
  - Act as a liaison between providers and state programs
  - Educate and promote the Texas Health Steps program within the community
  - Identify gaps in program resources, and develop Corrective Actions Plans
  - Prepare reports and studies on provider relations
