


Skills and experiences you may have developed through your degree include:

Examples of Entry-Level Job Postings (with Texas DSHS)

- Patient Outreach Specialist
 - Collaborate with patient care teams to assess/address patient population needs;
 develop training programs that improve patient satisfaction and outcomes
- Provider Relations Representative
 - Provide recruitment, referral and education/training for programs while identifying and responding to provider needs
- HIV Prevention Consultant
 - Manage projects to integrate HIV testing into routine care; participate in educational efforts to promote the adoption of routine HIV/STD/HCV testing
