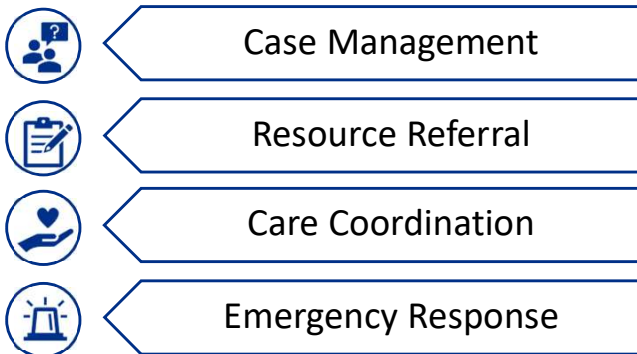
Social Work

Example of Entry-Level Job Posting (with Texas DSHS)

- **Social Worker II**
 - Case management duties, including intake, the completion of Family Needs Assessment, Service Plan, and follow up services
 - Connect families to community resources and provide referrals
 - Complete administrative duties and reports
 - Collaborate with other community entities on health, social work, case management, and other related issues
- **Required:** Current permanent license to practice as social worker in Texas (LBSW, LMSW, LMSW-AP, or LCSW) **Preferred:** Spanish speaking
