ADV - 10

The flood conditions that prompted the issuance of Fish and Shellfish Consumption Advisories; ADV - 8 and ADV - 9 have stabilized, spills of petroleum products have abated, and cleanup efforts are nearing completion. Therefore, these advisories are rescinded immediately.

COUNTIES: Chambers, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery and Galveston

AREA: San Jacinto River, Trinity River, Upper Galveston Bay west of the Houston Ship Channel.

SPECIES AFFECTED: All fish and shellfish species

CUNSUMPTION ADVISORY: Previous consumption advisories; ADV - 8 and ADV - 9 are rescinded.

Consumption Advisory-3 related to Dioxin Contamination of crabs and catfish in the Houston Ship Channel remains in effect.
